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

the Fine Arts Department. She holds an MFA in directing from the University of Memphis, and an M.Ed. in curriculum and instruction from Freed-Hardeman University. A recipient of the NEH grant Shakespeare and the Creative Act, she is a former Peer Grant Advisor for the Tennessee Arts Commission and a former board member of Tennesseans for the Arts. She is also the inaugural recipient of the Most Inspiring Teacher Award from the Orpheum High School Musical Theatre Awards, and a finalist for the Tony Award for Teachers. She is so pleased to be back at Theatre Memphis, her home for 20 years. She has been seen in such plays as The Addams Family, Othello, Bat Boy the Musical, Into the Woods, Six Degrees of Separation, Bug, King Lear, Richard III, Buffalo Gal, Boston Marriage, A Little Night Music, Hamlet, The Pavilion, Once Upon a Mattress, and Once on this Island, for which she won an Ostrander for best actress. She has directed such productions as Lizzie, Jesus Christ Superstar, Amadeus, Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat, Romeo and Juliet, Godspell, Fiddler on the Roof, and The Wizard of Oz.
